The defendants assail the correctness of the order passed by the trial Court on 29.10.2021, while closing their opportunity to lead further evidence after noticing that they have already availed as many as 9 effective opportunities.

The learned counsel representing the petitioners contends that all these opportunities were granted during the period when COVID infections were on the rise. He submits that if one last opportunity is granted, the defendants will produce their entire evidence.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and without commenting on merits, the revision petition is disposed of while directing the trial Court to grant one last opportunity to the defendants to lead their entire evidence which shall be subject to costs of Rs.10,000/- payable to the plaintiffs by way of Demand Draft.

The payment of costs shall be condition precedent of grant of an opportunity.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
