Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.13 dated 26.01.2022 under Sections 324/34 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 08.03.2022: -

“...The role attributed to the petitioner is of having caused a sharp edged weapon injury on the hands/palm of the complainant-Mohinder Kaur. Initially the FIR was registered under Section 324 IPC. However, Section 326 IPC was added later on. The Counsel for the petitioner submits that the opinion whereby Section 326

IPC has been added is from a private hospital. She contends that the allegations as levelled in the FIR are absolutely baseless. It is case of version and cross version...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh and on the basis of reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dharamkot, District Moga, filed in the Court today, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 08.03.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
