Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the order passed by the Division Bench of this Court in *LPA No.1273 of 2018 titled as State of Haryana and others versus Devender, decided on 20.02.2019 (Annexure P-3)*, the petitioner is entitled for higher salary while working on the post of chowkidar. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that despite being entitled, the petitioner is not being paid the salary, hence, the respondents are liable to be directed to grant the petitioner the arrears of salary along with interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already submitted a representation to the respondents on 09.01.2020 (Annexure P-4), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound

direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the representation of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 09.01.2020 (Annexure P-4), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 09.01.2020 (Annexure P-4) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for the monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to the petitioner within four weeks thereafter.
