This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate and necessary order/directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of the private respondents, who are father-in-law, brother-in-law and sister-in-law of the brother of the petitioner.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 26.02.2022 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, but no action has been taken by the police, so far. At this stage, he confines his prayer to the extent that the petitioner would be satisfied, if his aforesaid representation is decided by respondent No. 2, within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 State only.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, to decide the representation dated 26.02.2022 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
