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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

Petitioner has assailed the order dated 7.2.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by trial Court whereby non bailable warrants have been issued against petitioner for 14.3.2022.

The petitioner is an accused in case FIR No. 65, dated 23.3.2020 registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar. The allegations made are that petitioner alongwith co accused was found in possession of 5 gram of heroin. The petitioner and his co accused were released on bail.

It is the case of petitioner that after getting bail, he had been regularly appearing before the trial Court on each and every date. However, on 7.12.2021, petitioner did not appear before trial Court because of which bail bond and surety bond were ordered to be forfeited to State and non bailable warrants were issued against him.

Learned counsel for petitioner states that non appearance of petitioner before trial Court was not intentional. Infact, petitioner had wrongly noted the date. He states that petitioner would appear before trial Court on the date fixed i.e. 14.3.2022.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S. Khaira, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent State.

The petitioner may appear before trial Court on or before the date fixed i.e. 14.3.2022. On his doing so, he shall be admitted to bail by trial Court to its satisfaction. This shall however be subject to deposit of an amount of Rs. 10000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with the Director PGI Chandigarh Poor Welfare Patient Fund. He shall also furnish an undertaking that he would appear before the Court as and when directed.

The execution of impugned order shall be held in abeyance till appearance of petitioner on 14.3.2022.
