By this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking a direction to respondent No.1 to decide his appeal dated 20.12.2022 (Annexure P-3) on merits, stated to be pending before respondent No.1, stated to have been filed pursuant to the order dated 13.12.2021 (Annexure P-2) passed by this Court in CWP No.25181 of 2021.

On advance notice, learned counsel appearing for the State submits that what is termed as an appeal in the petition, i.e. Annexure P-3, is actually a representation but even so, the petitioner can appear before the Additional Chief Secretary, Town and Country Planning Department, Haryana, on 31.03.2022, and upon rectification of the format of the representation into an appeal, it would be decided expeditiously.

Consequently, it is directed that upon that being done by the petitioner, the appeal be decided within a period of three months thereafter.

As regards any issue on third party rights accruing, if the petitioner has any grievance, that would be looked into as per law by the appellate authority.

The petition is disposed of.
