Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case, the challenge is to the order of transfer dated 02.3.2021, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-7, whereby, respondent No.4 was transferred at the place of petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 05.3.2021, the operation of the transfer order was stayed and the petitioner continued to work at Government College for Women, Karnal.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that respondent No.4 has already retired.

Learned State counsel submits that respondent No.4 was

transferred at Government College for Women, Karnal, where the petitioner was working as extension Lecturer.

While issuing notice of motion, operation of the impugned order was stayed and the petitioner continued to work at Government College for Women, Karnal.

Learned State counsel submits that as respondent No.4 has already retired from service and the petitioner is already continuing working at Government College for Women, Karnal, the impugned order will not be given effect to.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.

Order accordingly.
