Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners are entitled for proportional increments, keeping in view the service rendered by them in a particular year, which is in consonance with the judgment of the Division Bench of Madras High Court passed in CWP No.15732-2017 titled as **P. Ayyamperumal vs. Union of India**, which judgment has already attained finality upto the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that for the claim, which is being raised in the present writ petition, the petitioners have already served a legal notice dated 30.07.2021 (Annexure P/4) with the

respondents, which is still pending consideration with them and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raj Karan Singh Brar, Addl. A.G. Haryana who has joined the proceedings through video conference accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding legal notice dated 30.07.2021 (Annexure P/4) submitted by the petitioners in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in legal notice dated 30.07.2021 (Annexure P/4), respondent No.3 is directed to decide legal notice dated 30.07.2021 (Annexure P/4) submitted by the petitioners to them by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
