Present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 09.03.2022 and respondent No.2 was directed to look into the grievances of the petitioners as set out in the petitioners and take appropriate action for protection of their life and liberty.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sanjay Kumar submits that petitioner No.1 has got recorded her statement under Section 164 CrPC before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Naraingarh, wherein she has stated that she will live with petitioner No.2 till he attains the marriageable age and that police protection granted to them be also extended.

In view of the above, learned State counsel submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

No further orders are required to be passed in the present case.

Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
