SANT PARKASH, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 and also to decide representation dated 25.02.2022 (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioner.

It is submitted that petitioner and respondent No.6 met with each other two years ago and fell in love. They decided to marry each other but the parents of respondent No.6 are against their alliance and giving them threats. Respondent No.6 left her home on 23.02.2022 and since then, she has been residing with the petitioner. Now, the petitioner and respondent No.6 apprehend danger to their life at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 and with regard to the same, petitioner has also moved a representation dated 25.02.2022 (Annexure P-3), but till date, no action has been taken on the same.

Now, the prayer on behalf of the petitioner is that a direction be issued to the official respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner in an expeditious manner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Ishneet Kaur, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and has no objection if an appropriate direction be issued for deciding the representation of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the instant criminal writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2–Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to decide the representation dated 25.02.2022 (Annexure P-3) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above said representation to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib for requisite compliance within the time period granted by this Court.
