Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, seeking a direction to the official respondents to lodge an FIR on the basis of complaint bearing No.193-D dated 24.02.2021, Annexure P-1, given by the petitioner in Women Cell, P.S. City, Panipat as counselling between the parties has failed.

A perusal of the petition shows that the marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with respondent No.7 in the year 2017, however, the petitioner was harassed and maltreated on account of dowry. On 24.02.2021, she submitted a complaint, Annexure P-1, and counselling took place, however, when she later enquired about the outcome of the complaint, she was informed that a closure report has been prepared as the matter has been compromised. A categoric assertion has been made in the petition that the petitioner never compromised the matter and she submitted a subsequent representation on 29.12.2021, Annexure P-5, addressed to the official respondents, but no action has been taken thereon.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the petition with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Panipat, respondent No.3 to examine the representation dated 29.12.2021, Annexure P-5, and to take suitable action thereon, as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of this order as well as representation, Annexure P-5, be sent to the Superintendent of Police, Panipat, respondent No.3, in order to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
