In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that the petitioner was entitled for promotion to the post of Principal but her juniors have been promoted without extending the said benefit to her, which according to the petitioner, is totally arbitrary and illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though notice of motion was issued but no reply has been filed by the respondents so far and the petitioner is going to attain the age of superannuation on 31.10.2022, hence, the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice submitted by the petitioner dated 13.01.2022, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-14 to be decided before her date of retirement.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that legal notice of the petitioner dated 13.01.2022 (Annexure P-14) will be decided by the competent authority within a period of 10 days from today and the decision so arrived will be informed to the petitioner forthwith.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, at this stage.
