Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of FIR No.240 dated 27.09.2019 registered under Section 376 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (Annexure P-1) alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

When confronted with the observations of Supreme Court in **State of Madhya Pradesh Vs. Laxmi Narayan and others 2019(2) RCR (Criminal) 255** that allegations attracting offences under a special statute cannot be quashed on the basis of compromise between the offender and the complainant, counsel for the petitioner has sought and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
