It has come out that while filing challan, Section 325 IPC has been added in the case.

Quashing of FIR No. 6, dated 5.1.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 341, 427, 506 IPC at Police Station Jhansa, District Kurukshetra and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners on the basis of compromise has been sought.

Vide order dated 10.3.2022, parties were directed to appear before Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court concerned for recording their statements and trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of compromise.

Report dated 31.3.2022 of learned JMIC, Kurukshetra has been received wherein it is stated that in view of joint statement of the parties, the Court is satisfied that parties have voluntarily entered into compromise to bring harmony and peace between them. The said compromise/settlement is genuine and is not result of any pressure or coercion in any manner.

In view thereof, petition is allowed. FIR No. 6, dated 5.1.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 341, 427, 506 IPC at Police Station Jhansa, District Kurukshetra and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners are quashed.
