VIKAS BAHL, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 48 dated 09.03.2013 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising on the basis of the compromise.

On 23.03.2018, a coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to direct the parties for getting their statements recorded. A perusal of the report dated 07.08.2018 received from Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rajpura would show that the complainant had failed to appear before the trial court to get his statement recorded inspite of several opportunities granted to him. No one had appeared on behalf of the petitioners or respondent No. 2 on 21.11.2018, 21.02.2019 or on 29.07.2019. On 29.07.2019, it was observed by the coordinate Bench of this Court that

one victim Manjinder Singh has not been arrayed as respondent in the present petition. Today also, the matter has been called twice. However, none has appeared on behalf of the parties.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise in case the compromise is still valid and parties are ready to get their statements recorded in support of the compromise and after making all the necessary parties including the said Manjinder Singh as respondent in the case.
