Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.09 dated 20.2.2021 registered under Sections 420, 498-A, 494, 406 IPC at Police Station, Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

By virtue of the order dated 19.7.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 19.7.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation. He has further submitted that the petitioner has been found innocent in the investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 19.7.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
