Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.12 dated 16.01.2019 under Sections 406 and 420 IPC (467, 468, 471 IPC added later) registered at Police Station Ambala Sadar, District Ambala.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 09.03.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Chand Ram submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 09.03.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 09.03.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
