This revision has been filed under Article 227 Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 24.01.2020 (Annexure P-7) passed by Addl. Civil Judge, (Sr. Divn.), Fazilka, whereby the application filed by the petitioner for seeking extension of time to deposit the balance sale consideration of an amount for Rs.4,20,000/- was dismissed.

Learned counsel states that the suit filed by the plaintiff/petitioner seeking specific performance of the agreement dated 07.07.2015 was decreed in his favour and defendant/judgment debtor was directed to get the sale deed executed in a period of one month and in the event of non-compliance, plaintiff was given liberty to get the sale deed executed through the process of Court. He submits that through the impugned order, the Civil Court dismissed his application seeking extension of time for depositing the balance sale consideration of Rs.4,20,000/-, but he does not press this petition, in order seek the intervention of the Court by filing an appropriate execution application.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
