1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 13.10.2021, in CWP-21062-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 13.10.2021, reveals that CWP-21062-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner as contained in representations dated 16.04.2021 and 15.07.2021, within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to payment, if any, to release the same to the petitioner within six weeks thereafter.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that claim of the petitioner as contained in representations dated 16.04.2021 and 15.07.2021, has been decided by the respondents and payment as per entitlement determined, released to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to

withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
