Petitioner, a widow, is seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to waive the interest on house building advance loan in case of her late husband Shri A.R. Jain, SDE, PWD, Public Health, Panipat Sub Division No.4.

Petition was filed in the year 1997 and has been lying admitted ever since. When called for hearing today, both learned counsels are unable to assist the Court for lack of instructions. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite attempts, his office could not contact the petitioner, whereas on the other hand learned counsel for the State submits that he made attempts to get instructions from the office representatives of the respondents, but for lack of any assistance, he is unable to address arguments.

It seems that by sheer effluxion of time and pendency of the writ petition for about 25 years before this Court, either it has been rendered infructuous or even otherwise the petitioner seems to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

Be that as it may, writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application in case any cause of action still survives.
