The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the impugned PPO (Annexure P1), and for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the respondents to decide the representation dated 27.09.2019 (Annexure P-5) and to refix the pension of the petitioner.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the representation dated 27.09.2019 (Annexure P5) and decide the same in accordance with law

by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
