[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 22.01.2021, in CWP No.8826 of 2020 in case titled as ***Darshan Singh vs. State of Punjab and others.***

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the parties jointly state that order, Annexure P-1 dated 22.01.2021 in CWP No.8826 of 2020, was challenged by way of LPA No.1098 of 2021 and on 18.11.2021, while issuing notice of motion, Hon'ble the Division Bench ordered that no further steps be taken to implement the orders of the learned Single Judge by way of contempt proceedings. The aforesaid order is reproduced as under :-

“Issue notice in the main appeal as well as in the application for condonation of delay returnable by 10.03.2022.

In the meanwhile, no further steps in the contempt petition shall be taken against the appellants without leave of the Court.”

[3] Learned State counsel further states that now the LPA is listed for hearing before Hon’ble the Division Bench on 23.02.2023.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such, at this stage while granting liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the instant petition, in the eventuality of modification of interim orders as referred to above or LPA No.1098 of 2021 being decided in favour of the petitioner whichever is earlier.

[5] Learned State counsel states that he has no objection to the proposed course of action.

[6] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is disposed of as not pressed, at this stage, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
