The petitioner has been debarred from taking the Transport Pilot Examination on the ground of adoption of unfair means in the previous examination. His appeal against the order is pending before respondent No. 2. The appeal was filed on 23.12.2020 and Rule 3B of Aircrafts Rules, 1937 stipulates that the appeal should be decided within a period of 30 days and yet the appeal is pending. Thus, a direction be issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the pending appeal expeditiously and preferably in a time bound manner.
