This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.130, dated 27.05.2000, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom. The petitioner has also prayed for quashing of consequent charges dated 18.07.2013 (Annexure P-31).

In this case, notice of motion was issued on 26.04.2012 and further proceedings before the trial Court were stayed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, however, submits that the petitioner as well as respondent No.4-complainant both have died during the pendency of the present petition.

Respondent-complainant was also represented through counsel and had filed reply. Even the State had filed reply to the petition.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.4-complainant affirms the fact qua respondent No.4-complainant having died.

Learned State counsel also submits that he also received information from the Investigating Officer that accused and complainant both have expired.

In view of the above, present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
