MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.18 dated 29.03.2018 under Sections 20 and 29 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Shahpur Kandi, District Pathankot, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police, pursuant to the non-bailable warrants issued against him vide order dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure P-5)

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that during trial, the petitioner was granted the concession of regular bail, but when he absented, the said concession was cancelled and arrest warrants were issued against him to secure his presence.

Considering the above background as well as the decision of this Court dated 04.04.2019 delivered by this Court in **CRM-M No.15464 of 2019 (Balwant Singh @ Banta Versus State of Punjab)**, the present

petition is not maintainable, therefore, the same is dismissed.

However, it shall be open for the petitioner to avail the appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
