This is an application filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for impleadment of legal heirs of respondent No.2 in the main case.

Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioners has submitted that the main case is now listed for 11.10.2022 and he wishes to withdraw the same with liberty to file fresh petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise after impleading all the legal representatives of respondent No.2 and also after placing on record the compromise which has been signed by all the legal representatives of respondent No.2 and thus, prays for preponement of the main case from 11.10.2022 to today itself.

Notice in the application.

On advance notice, Mr. Sarabjit S. Cheema, AAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of non-applicant/State and has submitted that he has no objection in case the date of hearing in the main case is

preponed from 11.10.2022 to today itself for final disposal.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present application is disposed of while preponing the date of hearing in the main case from 11.10.2022 to today and the same is accordingly taken on Board today itself for final disposal.

Main case

This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.93 dated 01.08.2020 registered under Sections 323, 324, 427, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise after impleading all the legal representatives of respondent No.2 and also after placing on record the compromise which has been signed by all the legal representatives of respondent No.2.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
