Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.0034 dated 29.01.2019 under Sections 22-B and 22-C Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa, Haryana, who is in custody since his arrest on 17.05.2019.

As per prosecution case, 95 boxes containing 19000 capsules Parvorin-Spas Ridley Tramadol were recovered from the plastic bag lying on the motor-cycle, which falls under the commercial quantity.

Learned State counsel has stated that prosecution has already examined 17 prosecution witnesses out of total 24 witnesses and trial is at the advanced stage.

Considering the above, it appears that the trial will conclude in the near future, therefore, keeping in view the nature and quantity of the contraband, no case is made out for extending the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
