This petition has been filed praying for quashing of the FIR No.227 dated 12.10.2020, under Sections 323, 354, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar Rural along with subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 04.03.2022 (Annexure P-3).

It is submitted that earlier the cancellation report was filed in this case. However, the Magistrate directed the investigating agency to investigate the same and during the pendency of the same, the parties have amicably settled the dispute. It is submitted that the FIR be quashed.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rakeshinder Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Vipin Kumar, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

On instructions from SI Besman Singh, who is present in the Court, learned State counsel submits that after investigation, again cancellation report has been prepared which is yet to be presented before the Court of Illaqa Magistrate. He further submits that the cancellation report

prepared would be presented in the Court of concerned Illaqa Magistrate within seven days from today. He also submits that in all, there are three accused, out of which, two accused are juvenile.

After hearing counsel for the parties, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the parties to avail the remedies as available to them before the Court concerned where the cancellation report is to be filed.
