Petition was filed in the year 1998, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to consider and promote the petitioner to the post of 'Senior Scale Stenographer' under BC category from the date respondent No.4 was promoted with all consequential service benefits.
