Complaining violation of directions issued by the Court in CWP-12757-2018, titled as “Rajinder Yadav Vs. State of Punjab and others”, dated 23.10.2018, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the order reads as under:-

*“Learned State counsel submits that petitioner has not completed the term required for consideration of his case for premature release. It shall be promptly considered by the authority on completion of the term as per Rules.*

*In view of statement made by learned State counsel, present petition is hereby disposed of.”*

In reply, learned counsel for the respondents on instructions submits that a decision in this regard shall be taken within a period of three weeks, positively, from today.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed.
