This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.729 dated 21.11.2021 under Section 379A read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sector-10A, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the present case the compromise has been effected between the parties and a petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of said compromise bearing CRM-M-10462-2022 titled as '*Manoj Kumar and another Vs. State of Haryana and another*' is pending for 20.05.2022. Learned counsel for the petitioners has further informed the Court that in pursuant to the order dated 10.03.2022 in CRM-M-10462-2022, statements of the parties including that of the complainant have been recorded before the Illaqa Magistrate on 21.03.2022 with regard to the effecting of compromise between the parties.

The aforesaid facts have not been controverted either by learned counsel for the complainant as well as for the State of Haryana.

In the light of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I deem it appropriate to allow the benefit of regular bail to the petitioners. The petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Gurugram.
