The present petition has been filed with a prayer for directing the respondents to issue appointment/selection letter to petitioner for the post of Lower Divisional Clerk (UHBVNL), which were advertised vide Advertisement No.11 of 2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after competing for the said post, as per the result declared, the petitioner was at No.8 in the waiting list keeping in view the vacancies advertised and thereafter a large number of candidates have been appointed from the waiting list but the petitioner has not been given the appointment for the reasons best known to the respondents. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has been filing the representations to the respondents to give the details of

appointments made out of waiting list and also to appoint her, as according to her, the persons junior to her in the merit were appointed whereas she has been ignored for appointment. Learned counsel submits that the representations filed by the petitioner starting from Annexure P-4 onwards have been appended alongwith the present petition and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case, the respondent Haryana Staff Selection Commission is directed to decide the representation dated 15.5.2021 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 15.5.2021 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition or in the representation dated 15.5.2021 (Annexure P-4), the respondent No.1 is directed to decide the representation dated 15.5.2021 (Annexure P-4) within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
