Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.28 dated 03.06.2020 under Section 420 IPC and Section 66-C and 66-D of Information and Technology Act, 2000 registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 10.03.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State has filed reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Amrik Singh Chahal, DSP, Sub Division Bholath, Kapurthala on behalf of respondent-State in Court, which is taken on record and on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 10.03.2022 and is not required for

custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 10.03.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
