The prayer in the petition under Section 439 Cr.PC is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.71 dated 21.07.2020 under Sections 15 & 18 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Kheri Nodh Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

On 17.08.2022 the following order was passed by this Court:-

*This application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved by applicant/petitioner-**Dharminder Singh** seeking extension of interim bail granted to him, vide order dated 22.07.2021.*

A bare perusal of medical certificate dated 15.11.2021

(Annexure P/6) issued by Jeevan Multispeciality Hospital and Trauma Center, Rajan Nursing Home Complex, near Garden Resort, Rajbaha Road, Patiala, reveals that on account of treatment of AVN (R) Hip, applicant-petitioner requires bed rest for at least two months.

In view of above, instant application is disposed of and interim bail already granted to applicant/petitioner-Dharminder Singh, vide order dated 22.07.2021 is extended till 04.02.2022.

Applicant/petitioner-Dharminder Singh is directed to surrender before Superintendent, District Jail, Rupnagar, on 05.02.2022 at 10:00 A.M. sharp.

Main Case

Adjourned to 07.02.2022. ”

The Counsel for the state submits that the petitioner did not surrender in terms of the aforesaid order on the given date and time and in fact moved another application for extension of bail and the interim bail already granted to the petitioner was extended on 07.02.2022.

As per the counsel for the State the petitioner has not surrendered so far before the Superintendent Jail, Rupnagar.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 02.12.2021 and 07.02.2022 are recalled. The interim bail granted to the petitioner is cancelled. The SSP, Fatehgarh Sahib is directed to arrest the petitioner and produce him before the Superintendent Jail, Rupnagar within one week from the receipt of copy of this order.

The Counsel for the State submits that the petitioner has since been arrested in FIR No.380 dated 2.7.2022 under Sections 8, 18 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station Sihahigate, District Gaziabad, U.P.

In view of the above, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
