Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.10 dated 30.01.2020, under Sections 498-A, 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Chhajali, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 25.02.2020 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 25.02.2020, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Taara Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 25.02.2020 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
