1. This order shall dispose of aforesaid two petitions filed on behalf of Rohtash Kadiyan & another as well as Chhabil Das respectively, seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against them vide FIR No.8 dated 20.01.2020 at Police Station Kalka, District Panchkula, under Section 174-A IPC.

2. Learned State counsel upon instructions has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, all the petitioners have since joined investigation and are not required for any custodial interrogation.
3. Having regard to the aforestated position, wherein allegations pertain to an offence under Section 174-A IPC and the petitioners have already joined investigation, it is not a case where their custodial interrogation is warranted. Both the petitions, as such, are accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide orders dated 25.02.2020 and 18.03.2020 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
