Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.447 dated 24.12.2019, under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 4 of The Muslim Women (Protection of Rights on Marriage) Act, 2019, registered at Police Station Old Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Vide order dated 08.02.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 08.02.2022, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 has opposed the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Kesh Ram, affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and

they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 08.02.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
