Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.23 dated 31.01.2022, registered for offences under Sections 498-A, 323, 406 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Kalka, Panchkula, Annexure P-1.

While issuing notice of motion on 10.03.2022, this Court directed the petitioner-husband to join the investigation. However, he did not do so and on 08.08.2022, this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the order of this Court dated 10.03.2022 the petitioner has not joined investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner disputes the above statement made on behalf of the State.

Without commenting on the above, it is directed that the petitioner shall now appear before the concerned Assistant Commissioner of Police on 18.08.2022 to join investigation in the case where the investigating officer shall also be present.

Adjourned to 10.11.2022.

Interim order to continue.

Before the adjourned date, the State shall file a status report.”

State counsel has filed a status report by way of an affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Kalka, which is taken on record, wherein it has been deposed that even on 18.08.2022, the petitioner had failed to join the investigation.

In view of the above, as the petitioner has failed to comply with the order passed by this Court, the petition is ordered to be dismissed.
