The prayer in the petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of necessary directions to respondent nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners which is said to be in danger at the hands of respondent nos.4 to 8 as the petitioners want to marry each other.

On 10.03.2022 notice of motion was issued and the matter was posted for hearing on 06.4.2022. After that matter has come up for hearing today.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

The Counsel for the State submits that the petitioners were not found at the given address mentioned in the petition and, therefore, no further proceeding could take place at their end.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. However, in case the petitioners still face any threat to their life and liberty they are at liberty to approach the investigating agency who shall proceed in accordance with law.
