HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 423 dated 07.09.2019, registered under Sections 120-B, 302, 364 IPC read with Section 34 IPC, at Police Station City Gohana, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case; that though there are specific allegations against the petitioner, yet the fact remains that complainant-Arjun and his mother-Sunita, while appearing as PW-13 and PW-8, have turned hostile; that the petitioner has been in custody since 11.09.2019 and that co-accused Banti, Amit @ Sarpanch and Umed, have already been granted regular bail by Coordinate Benches.

Learned State counsel, while vehemently opposing the prayer for bail, submits that there are specific allegations against the petitioner. However, he does not dispute the custody period of the petitioner and the facts that three co-accused have already been granted regular bail and the complainant as well as his mother have turned hostile.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has been in custody since 11.09.2019. The complainant and his mother have turned hostile. Three co-accused have already been granted regular bail by the Coordinate Benches. The conclusion of the trial would take time. Hence, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
