The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Notice of motion was issued on 11.03.2022. In compliance of order dated 11.03.2022 passed by this Court, Status report dated 19.03.2022 by way of affidavit of DSP, Sub Division (Rural) on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record.As per the said reply, representations of the petitioners was diarized and action was taken thereon. It is stated that petitioner No.1 is the mother of respondent No.4 and petitioner No.2 is minor daughter of respondent No.4 whereas respondent No.5 is second wife of respondent No.4. It has been found that on 17.12.2021, the private respondents forcibly damaged the wall of the petitioners and her complaint regarding said incident was filed to the police, on which, DDR No.21 dated 17.12.2021 under Section 427 IPC, PS Shahkot, District Jalandhar was registered against respondents No.4 and 5. Preventive action was taken under Section 107, 150 Cr.PC DDR No.20 dated 06.03.2022, PS Shahkot District Jalandhar against the private respondents. It is further found that a civil litigation between the petitioners

and private respondents is pending regarding the dispute of sharing the house in which the petitioners have been residing and the respondents have been claiming a share. A civil case bearing no.CS/607/2021 has been filed by son of petitioner No.1 against petitioners in the court of JMJC Nakodar, Jalandhar regarding the above said house property in which order of status quo has been passed.

ASI Gurjit Singh has personally met the petitioners and has given his Mobile number and the mobile number of the SHO, PS Shahkot, District Jalandhar to the petitioners so that in case of any assistance, they can call out to the police without any hesitation and delay.

In view of the fact that the appropriate proceedings have already been initiated, DDR under Section 427 PS Shahkot, District Jalandhar was registered against respondents No.4 and 5 and a civil case is already pending between the parties, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

However, it is made clear that the official respondents would ensure the security of the petitioners who are aged about 72 and 14 years respectively and would take appropriate action in accordance with law if the petitioners face any threat at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5.

Petition stands disposed of.
