[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 27.08.2020 in CWP No.12927 of 2020.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that while issuing notice of motion in CWP No.12927 of 2020, interim orders were granted in the same terms as in CWP No.9851 of 2020, whereas a perusal of order dated 15.07.2020 in CWP No.9851 of 2020 reveals that while issuing notice of motion, it was ordered that operation of the impugned orders dated 12.06.2020 and 07.11.2017 would remain stayed.

[3] The petitioner appearing in person states that the orders impugned in CWP No. 9851 of 2020 as well as in CWP No.12927 of 2020 were the same as the action in the aforesaid orders were identical qua the petitioner in CWP No.9815 of 2020 as well as CWP No. 12927 of 2020.

[4] Learned AAG has filed reply dated 11.07.2022 along with Annexure R/1 dated 30.05.2022. Copy thereof supplied to the petitioner who on perusal thereof states that in view of order, Annexure R/1 dated

30.05.2022, she does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to take out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law to challenge action of the respondents in not releasing salary to her for a period of November 2020 till July 2022.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of petitioner, who is appearing in person, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
