The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents No.1 & 2 to enquire the matter and take strict legal action against respondents No.4 to 6; along with certain other prayers.

A perusal of the case file itself shows that the matter pertains to some property dispute, which is not appropriate to be entertained in the writ proceedings.

In view of the above, this court does not find anything to interfere in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail alternate civil remedy for resolving the dispute with regard to the property in question.
