The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.233 dated 09.06.2021 registered under Sections 365, 376(3) IPC and Sections 4, 8, 12 and 17 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 at Police Station Gandhi Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since in the petitioner's trial the entire evidence has already been led and the matter is now listed for final arguments, he does not press the present petition on its merits and would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to finally dispose of the petitioner's trial within a time bound manner.

Learned State counsel has no objection if the above alternate prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is accepted.

Every under trial has a right to speedy trial.

In view of the above as also in the facts of the present case where the entire evidence has already been led, the above alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is found to be reasonable and accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to finally dispose of the petitioner's trial by 31st July 2022, in accordance with law.
