Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.37 dated 08.02.2019, registered for offences under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Women Police Station, District Ludhiana, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioners submits that the matrimonial dispute between the parties has been settled and he be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a separate petition seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of the compromise.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.

In pursuance to order dated 18.03.2021, the petitioners have deposited demand draft(s) totalling ₹70,000/- drawn in the name of complainant-respondent No.2 with the Registrar General of this Court, the validity of which has expired.

The draft(s) are ordered to be returned to the petitioners with a direction that they will get them revalidated or issued afresh and hand them over to the complainant on the day when the petition seeking quashing on the basis of the compromise, to be instituted by the petitioners, comes up for hearing.
