[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 16.10.2019, in CWP No.29776 of 2019 in case titled as '**Kuldeep Singh and another** versus **State of Punjab and another**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.29776 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representations dated 19.09.2017 and 20.11.2017 respectively, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Reply dated 31.01.2022 was filed in the Registry and copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners. The reply is taken on record.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of speaking order (Annexure R-1) dated 04.03.2021, accepting the claim of

the petitioners as contained in the aforementioned representations, the petitioners do not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
