[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 05.09.2019 in CWP No.24397 of 2019 in case titled as Kirana Devi and others vs The State of Haryana and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 05.09.2019 reveals that CWP No.24397 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide legal notice dated 12.04.2019 by passing a well reasoned and speaking order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the said legal notice/representation was not decided within the stipulated period of time, costs of Rs.25,000/- were to be paid by the concerned officer to the petitioners.

[3] Reply along with order, Annexure R/1 dated 20.03.2020 has already been filed. As per Annexure R/1, information regarding the disputed vacant posts of PRT/JBT category was being collected from all

the DEEOs and further action for requisition of posts to HSSC would be made within two months.

[4] In compliance of order, Annexure P/1, learned DAG has also handed over costs of Rs.25,000/- in cash to the learned counsel for the petitioners in Court today, who in the circumstances states that in view of the needful having been done, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. Costs of Rs.25,000/- as paid in cash by learned DAG to the learned counsel for the petitioners be remitted to the petitioners.
