SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. After hearing the arguments, as, made on the petition, and, with the learned State counsel intimating this Court, that the investigating officer concerned, after holding investigations into FIR No.349 of 11.09.2021, instituted at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal, Haryana, has instituted a closure/cancellation report, before the learned Magistrate concerned. Consequently, in view of the above, the claimed relief therein, that despite grievous life endangering injuries becoming caused, upon the victim in sequel to his becoming allegedly assaulted by the accused, yet the investigating officer concerned, not adding the relevant provisions of the Indian Penal Code against the accused concerned, rather becomes not maintainable.

2. Though, this Court hence proceeds to dismiss the petition, as not maintainable, at this stage. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner to make a protest against the acceptance of the closure/cancellation report, as, filed before the learned Magistrate concerned.

3. Further liberty is also reserved to the petitioner to pray for further investigations being ordered to be carried out by the investigating officer concerned, in the FIR (supra).

4. Disposed of.
