This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the summoning order dated 13.11.2010 passed by JMIC, Ludhiana (Annexure P-2) and the complaint No.714/2 dated 13.11.2010 filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act (Annexure P-1).

2. The petition was ordered to be admitted on 21.08.2012. Thereafter, the matter was referred to Lok Adalat wherein, no effective effort could be made for settlement as respondent never appeared.

3. Today, Ms. Shreya Rana, Advocate for Mr. Vijay Rana, Advocate appears on behalf of the petitioner and submits that she has no instructions from the petitioner and probably owing to the time period of 12 years that have elapsed from the date of filing of the present petition and there being no interim, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

4. Disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.

5. Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed off.
