1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 22.10.2019, in CWP-30449-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 22.10.2019, reveals that CWP-30449-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondent to dispose of the online representation filed by the petitioner within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order after affording an opportunity of hearing and by passing aspeaking order, in accordance with law.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the representation of the petitionerhaving been rejected vide speaking order dated 13.08.2020, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 13.08.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
